We believe that addiction is a treatable brain disease that profoundly affects the lives of individuals, families, and communities. CREATE, Inc. is committed to providing our participants and their families with quality clinical services and treatments that are trauma-informed, patient-centered, and holistic. - All therapeutic services are provided in individual, group, and family modalities and are evidence-based.
- Medication Assisted Treatment (suboxone) is offered and used in conjunction with counseling and behavioral therapy, to provide a whole-patient approach to the treatment of substance use disorders.
- All participants are assigned to a Primary Counselor who will develop an individualized treatment plan that addresses all areas of concern to participants and their loved ones.
- Medical services, psychiatric services, vocational services and case management are available on-site.
