



Welcome to CREATE, Inc.! We provide a host of substance, mental health and residential services to meet our clients' needs. CREATE, Inc. has been serving the Harlem Community since 1971 for Outpatient and Inpatient substance abuse treatment, as well as providing Young Adult Shelter and Permanent Supportive Housing governed by DHS. CREATE, Inc. has also operated and funded a Food Pantry that serves our hungry neighbors on Wednesdays.

The Medically Supervised Outpatient Program identifies each participant's needs, and is based on holistic approach which follows a medical model to evaluate, assess and develop a treatment plan, agreed upon by the participant, primary counselor and Multi-Disciplinary professionals. As a clinical team we focus on the participant's level of care, medical and mental health, along with educational, vocational and suitable housing status

Health Homes at CREATE, Inc:

All participants that are referred to the CREATE, Inc. outpatient, CYAC and Residential areas will have the opportunity to receive Case Management services to monitor, connect and have emergency care for all their service needs coordinated by a care professional. CREATE, Inc. provides Outreach and Coordination of Care for Health Homes through our in-house representative from NADAP and CREATE, Inc. direct Health Homes Care coordination services as down Stream provider of Heritage Health Homes.

Participants progress through phases of treatment to integrate each member into the community with her or his new coping skills in order to reduce recidivism.

The CREATE, Inc. medically supervised outpatient program has developed multiple tracks to meet the participants' needs within each phase of treatment:
